INFORMATION AND SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The TypeGallery is a showcase of new typeface design that will be exhibited during TypeCon2003. All typefaces shown at TypeCon2003 will also become part of a permanent online exhibition at <http://www.typegallery.com>. Some works may also be selected for print publication by SOTA.

SPECIFICATIONS

- Typefaces must have been created, published, or significantly updated between June 2002 and June 2003.
- You may submit either a traditional type specimen or a typographic design piece displaying your font in use.
- Artwork may be in color or black and white.
- Maximum artwork size is 11"x15".
- Each submission must be mounted on an 11"x17" piece of white foamcore board. Leave a 2" or greater margin at the bottom of the board.
- Digital files must be provided for each submission. Supply 300 dpi PDFs or editable vector EPS files (Illustrator v8 or Freehand v10 or lower). Files must be Mac-compatible. Convert all fonts to paths in the illustration program, and embed all fonts in PDF files. Proof digital files carefully to ensure high quality appearance both onscreen and in print.
- Limit 3 typeface submissions from a single designer or foundry.

SUBMISSION FEES

- There is a nominal fee of \$15 per typeface submission to help cover costs. Fees are waived for SOTA members, TypeCon2003 attendees, speakers, and sponsors.
